



Product Data Sheet: Verdant Seed

Grey2Green verdant seed. Consists of 80 species, all of which are 100% UK native provenance. Verdant seed consists of only 5% grass to create, when sown a diverse and unique vegetation that will withstand the rigors of a green roof environment and provide forage for wildlife.

The provenance and mix seed has been prepared in consultation with leading ecologists who are members of the Institute of Ecology and Environmental Management and Chartered Environmentalists. Verdant plugs supports a species assemblage that can be tailored to meet project requirements and ensure that BREEAM ECO ratings are maximised, Biodiversity Action Plan species are supported and that there is an overall gain in biodiversity, in accordance with Planning Policy Statement 9.

Seed to be cast in a minimum depth of 100mm of biodiverse substrate. Irrigation may be required in drier regions.

Seed is best sown in the autumn or spring but can be sown at other times of the year if there is sufficient warmth and moisture. The seed must be surface sown: do not incorporate or cover the seed.

The requirement for aftercare will vary from scheme to scheme. Some will need minimal maintenance, perhaps only occasional tidying cuts for aesthetic reasons.
